

We are happy to invite you to worship together once more on Sunday mornings. Our services will look a little different and there will be some steps for all of us to take to keep everyone safe and to ensure we are functioning within the guidelines and requirements that have been set in place by our Saskatchewan government.

Due to social distancing requirements and comfort levels around public gatherings we recognize that not everyone will be able to attend every Sunday. We will continue to have an online service, one that will be live-streamed Sunday mornings at 10:30am. A copy of the service will be available on our YouTube channel for those unable to watch it live.

If you would like to attend a service in person you will need to pre-register during the week either by e-mailing or calling the church office. Registrations will close by Friday at noon each week. If spaces are filled you will be notified and registered for the next Sunday.

Your registration is your consent to abide by the guidelines that our leadership has set in place.

- Make sure you are feeling well. That you have not been out of the country the last 14 days or in contact with someone who has.
- Social distancing (2m, about 6 feet) must be maintained while on church property, apart from immediate family or those you have an established social bubble with (Sorry no hugs or handshakes just yet!).
- Bring a mask to wear if you would like to join in the singing (a limited supply of masks will be available).
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available for your use.
- Ushers will record your attendance and assist with seating. We ask that people remain in their assigned spots for the duration of the service. At the end of the service the ushers will dismiss people in an orderly way.

Some other things to keep in mind:

- Come early to help minimize congestion at the doors.
- Only the south doors will be open at this time.
- An offering box will be available as you enter and exit.
